Congratulations on your decision to enroll in the New Bedford High School, Evening Extension Program!

You've taken the first step toward your future goals.

In order to earn a New Bedford High School, Evening Extension Diploma, you must:

Forward an official transcript of previous high school courses and MCAS Scores (if applicable) to the NBHS, Evening Extension Program.

Meet with a program counselor, available during registration, for an evaluation of your transcript and to determine a "Program of Study."

Pass the MCAS Exam (English Language Arts and Mathematics) and provide official documentation of your scores.

Members of the class of 2010 and beyond must also pass MCAS Science.

One of the following: Biology, Chemistry, Introductory Physics, or Technology/Engineering

MCAS Retest Exam Dates/Fees:

Sign up with a program counselor as soon as possible. Testing dates for 2011-2012 are as follows:

Fall Math: November 9 & 10, 2011 - \$20
ELA: Nov. 14, 15, & 16, 2011 - \$30

Biology February 1 & 2, 2012 - \$20

Spring ELA: Feb. 29, March 1 & 2, 2012 - \$30
Math: March 5 & 6, 2012 - \$20

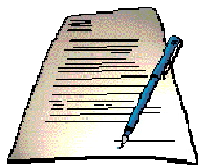

Graduation Requirements:



- Attain 20 units. (Official transcripts must be evaluated by a program counselor and approved by the program principal.)
- Successfully pass:
 - English I, II, III, IV
 - U.S. History I & II
 - Remaining units are electives
- Enroll and successfully complete a minimum of two courses with the Evening Extension Program.
- Achieve a passing score on the MCAS English Language Arts and Mathematics Exams as per MDESE, as applicable; satisfy the requirements of the Educational Proficiency Plan.
- Original members of the Class of 2010 and beyond must also attain a passing score on MCAS Science
- All accounts must be paid in full.

Units can also be earned/awarded:

(Units awarded upon approval.)

- Satisfactory score on the placement exam (up to four units)
- Proficiency in Portuguese or Spanish (max. of two units)
- Employment (documentation required)
- College courses (approval and official documentation required)
- Training Programs (approval and official documentation required)
- Military Service (official documentation required)
- Community Service (documentation required)
