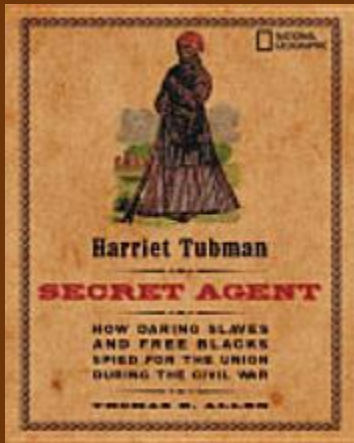


HARRIET TUBMAN : SECRET AGENT
