The New Bedford Secondary Summer School Program concentrates on academic make-up and review courses as well as enrichment classes for Middle School students. The Summer 2010 session will begin on Tuesday, July 6th and continue through Friday August 6, 2010. All classes will be held at New Bedford High School, Green House, located at 230 Hathaway Boulevard, New Bedford, Massachusetts. Enrollment is open to area Secondary and Middle School level students.

Classes meet daily, Monday through Friday. Participants are expected to attend all class sessions, complete quality class work, homework assignments, and successfully pass weekly tests in order to earn make-up credit. Adults are allowed to take a few specific courses for credit.

CLASSES/TUITION: Two class periods are offered for Middle School Participants: Period A (8:30-10:00 AM) and Period B (10:00-11:30 AM). The tuition is \$120.00 per course for New Bedford Residents and \$170.00 per course for non-residents. Tuition charges include a \$10.00 non-refundable registration fee. Acceptable methods of payment include certified check or money order made payable to City of New Bedford. Personal checks are not accepted.

Please Note: It is not possible to guarantee that certain classes will be held on a specific period.

High School block courses run from 8:30-11:30 a.m. Tuition is \$230.00 per block course for residents of New Bedford and \$325.00 per block course for non-residents. Tuition charges include a \$10.00 non-refundable registration fee. Acceptable methods of payment include certified check or money order made payable to City of New Bedford. Personal checks are not accepted.

ATTENDANCE/PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS: Participants are expected to attend all class sessions. If a student is absent make-up credit may not be granted. All classes follow an intensive program of study moving through a great deal of subject matter in a relatively short period of time. In addition to attendance, class work and active participation, learners will also be required to complete home assignments outside of class time. All courses are graded Pass/Fail, with a numerical average. A minimum of 65 is required to receive make-up credit.

STUDENT CONDUCT: All students must comply with the same general rules of proper conduct as apply during the regular school year. A student may be dropped from a course for unsatisfactory conduct and no refund of tuition will be given.

TRANSPORTATION: Limited transportation is provided for students who live more than two miles from New Bedford High School and reside in New Bedford. Consult the Transportation Schedule on page two to determine the closest pick-up point.

REVIEW/MAKE-UP CREDIT COURSES: Courses will only be held if there is sufficient enrollment.
