Math Education (M.A.)

Our Mathematics Education Master's is designed for **in-service K-12 teachers** and can be started in summer, fall, or spring. The program's required courses may be adapted to fit an educator's practicing position and interests. Classes are completed over 8-weeks and taken one class at a time. Flexible scheduling in the evening and weekends accommodate full-time employment.

STEM Education (M.A.)

Our STEM Education Master's is designed for **in-service teachers** and can be started in summer, fall, or spring. In-person classes are taught at our Bristol campus on select Saturdays and all other learning is remote. The capstone experience provides educators experiential learning in a dynamic STEM environment such as K-12 schools, science museums, or community organizations.
